**Warren Ives**—his funeral service will be held at **West London Crematorium** on Tuesday December 12th at 9.30am

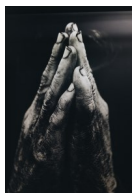
**Madeline Dorrington**—her funeral service will be held at

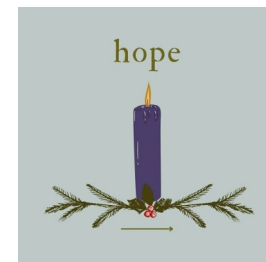
