The dates for the **Oblate Pilgrimage to Lourdes** are September 17th-22nd.

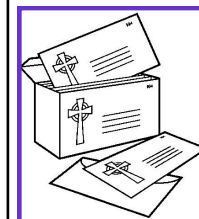
Booking forms are arriving shortly. There are **NO** seats lefts.
