This week at nursery:

To help your child:

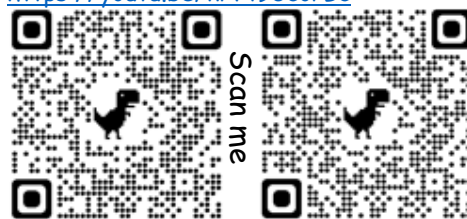
- Sit with them and **read** for 10 minutes (or more!!) every day.

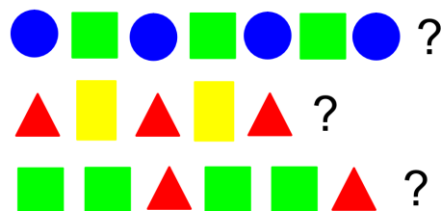

Maths:

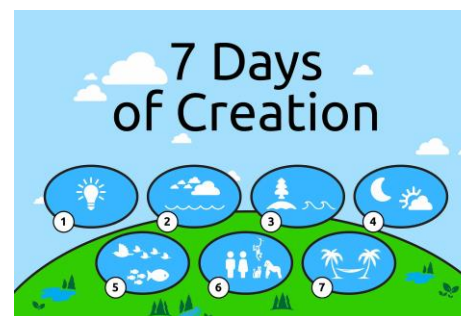
We have been talking about **patterns**.
