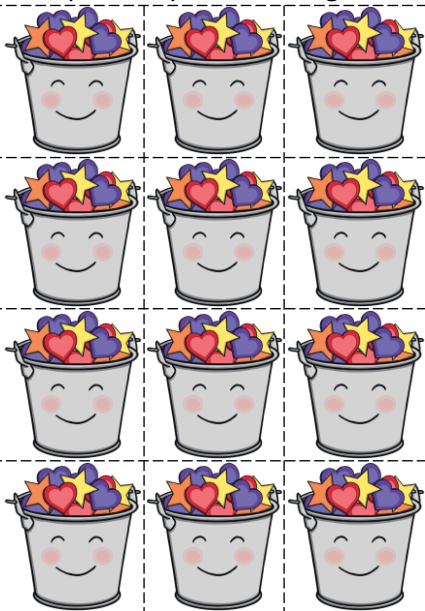


St. Mary's Catholic Primary School Weekly Nursery Newsletter

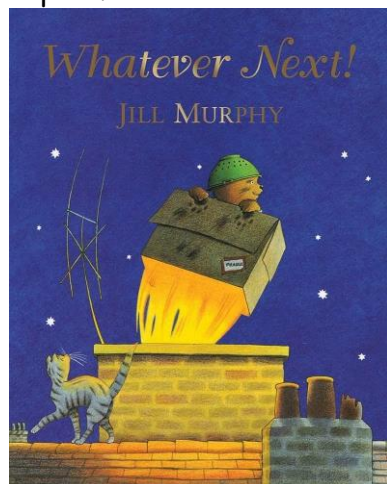
This week at nursery:

- Slowly count objects, one by one, up to 10 things.



Literacy:

Maths:

We have been exploring one more and one less. Practising counting and then working out what amount is one more or one less than a group.



Religious Education:

We have been hearing the story of how Jesus was born to Mary and Joseph in Bethlehem.



Homework:



Ask about Mary and Joseph.

Bring in any large, clean boxes or bottles for our junk modelling work.

Add t and i to your sound games at home. (m, a, s, d and t, i now)

Talk with your child about what makes them special; their name, their family, their culture or language, their likes and dislikes, their skills.

Play lots of counting games at home.
