

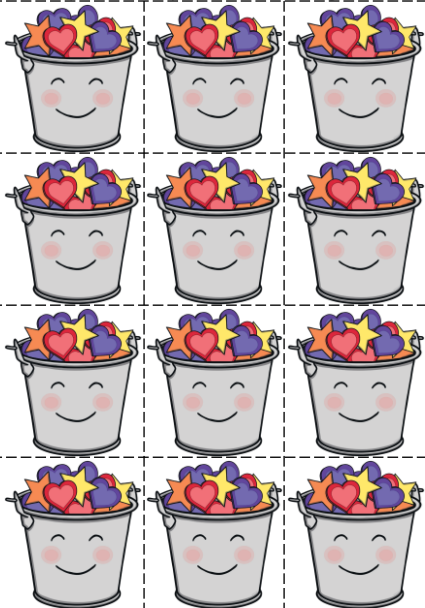


St. Mary's Catholic Primary School Weekly Nursery Newsletter

Everyday good practices:

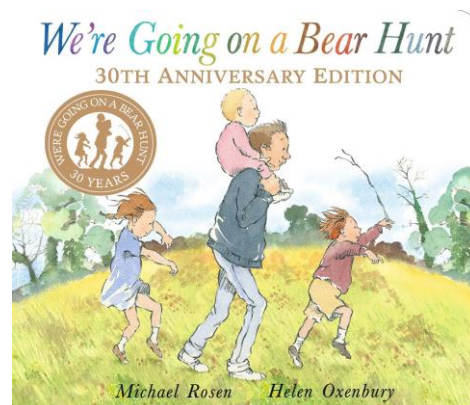
- Sit with them and **read** for 10 minutes (or more!!) every day.

Ask your child to tell you the story.

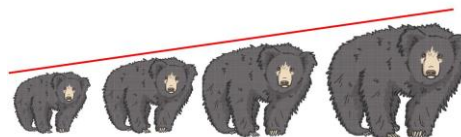


We have been repeating our counting nursery rhymes to remember the numbers and practice counting.

- One, two buckle my shoe

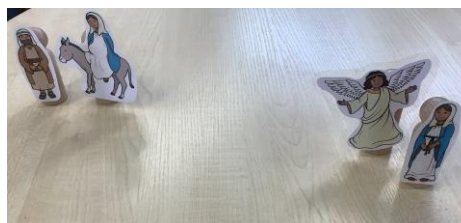
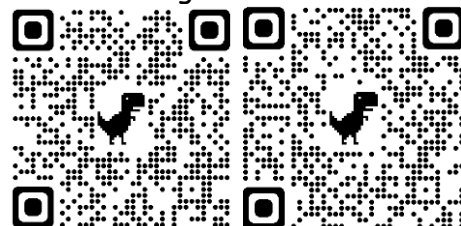
Maths:
