



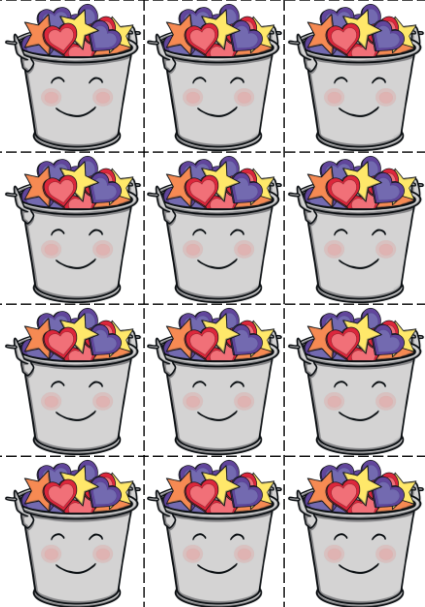

We made story boards to show the events of our class story.

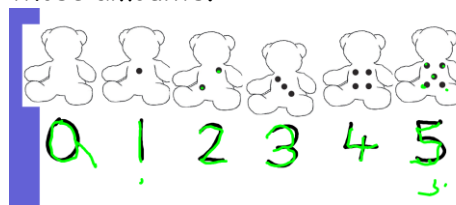


We have been tracing some of letters we have learned.
