

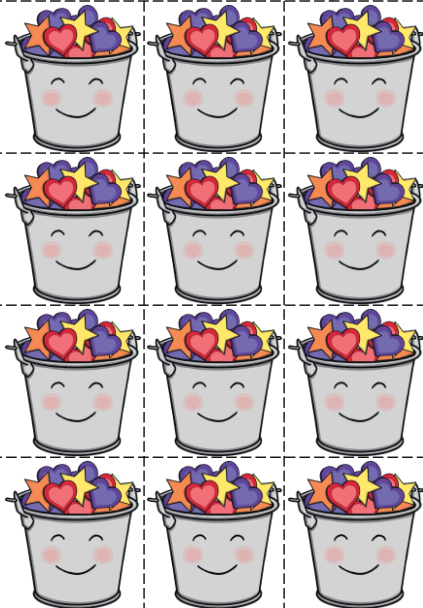


St. Mary's Catholic Primary School Weekly Nursery Newsletter

This week at nursery:

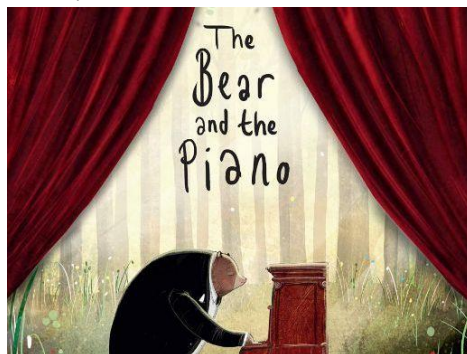
Everyday good practices:

Sticking with our bear theme, we enjoyed The Bear and the piano this week. We talked about the story and played the piano in class.

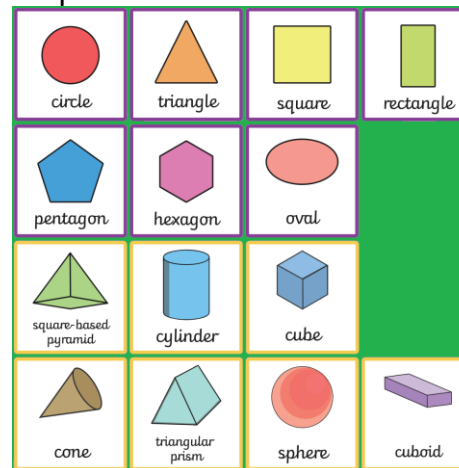


We have been talking about why it is important to have rules, in class, at home and in the whole country.
