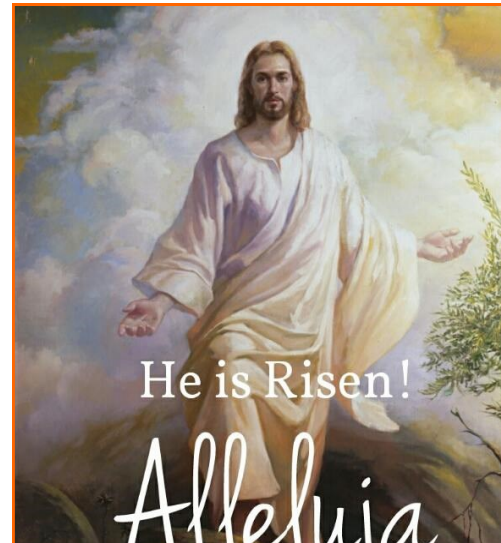
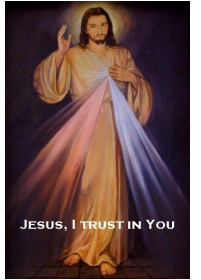

Doubting Thomas

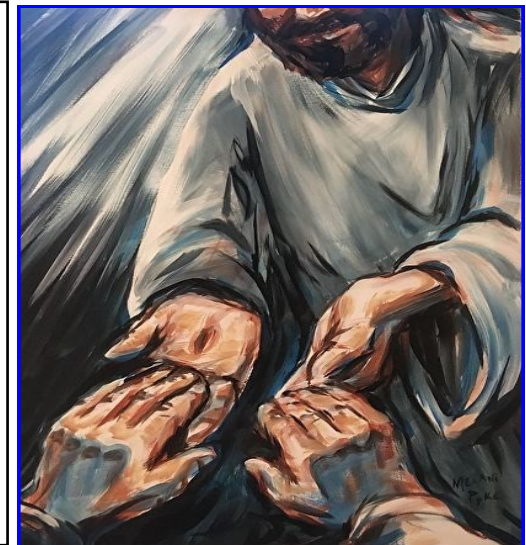
In today's Gospel reading we encounter Thomas, the Apostle, known as **Doubting Thomas**.
