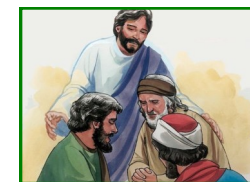

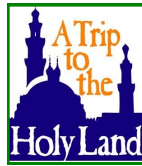
Communion/Confirmation

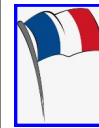
